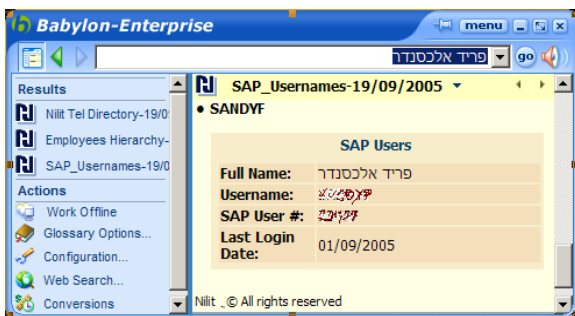

Babylon-Enterprise also gives Nilit sales managers instant access, from any desktop application, to the contact details of all of Nilit's customers.

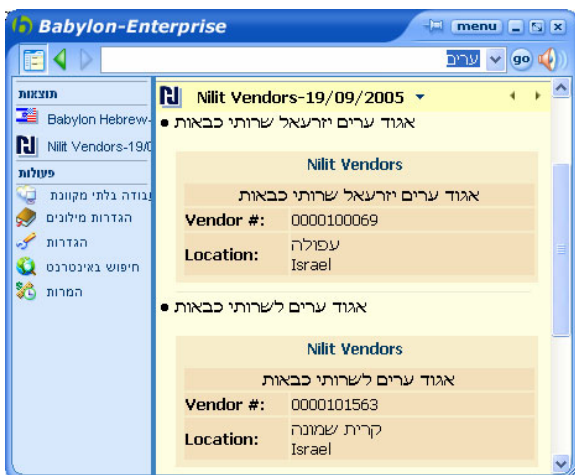
## Babylon-Enterprise Simplifies Information Retrieval and Exchange
